**Food Vendor Information**

Dear Food Vendor,

I am writing to invite you to participate in **Berkeley Earth Day**, sponsored by the City of Berkeley. All food must be vegetarian and no styrofoam may be used. We would also appreciate you using recycled paper plates/cups etc, if at all possible instead of plastic. Please contact me if you have trouble finding a supplier.

Around 5,000 folks attended last year and we expect this year to be bigger because it is the 38th anniversary of Earth Day.

Berkeley Earth Day, slated for **Saturday, April 19** from 11am to 5:30 pm in Civic Center Park, will combine cultural performances and speakers on a wide range of environmental issues.

Here's the tentative schedule of activities:

- Demonstrations of renewable energy such as electric cars, hemp, paper free products and solar power
- Over 150 booths representing businesses, craftspeople, community organizations, food vendors and government groups
- Berkley Farmer's Market with mostly organic farmers

Please call me at (510) 654-6346 to discuss how we might work together. Vendors may rent a food booth structure for \$100 which conforms to City Of Berkeley Health regulations if they don't own a booth.

Included in your fee is a commitment to provide up to 10 meals to Earth Day organizers and volunteers when they present a voucher. You will be permitted to sell beverages.

If you need electricity please bring an extension cord. We now have outlets close to the stage, about 50-75 ft from farthest food booth.
